Stay On Top of Watering:

Heavy rains can be deceptive—check soil moisture before skipping irrigation.

Add Summer Color

Plant heat-lovers like lantana, purslane, caladiums, and pentas for bright garden beds.

Deadhead Regularly:

Remove faded blooms to encourage continuous flowering in annuals and perennials.

Watch for Fungal Diseases:

High humidity can cause leaf spots and root rot—ensure proper air circulation and avoid wetting foliage.

Fertilize Containers and Veggies:

Summer rains can wash nutrients away—use slow-release or diluted liquid fertilizers.

Start Planning for Fall:

Start seeds indoors for fall crops like broccoli, cabbage, and collards.
